  - Dump truck (including snowplows and sanders)
  - Pickup trucks

  - Other equipment/power tools as required
- Performs routine maintenance tasks such as, but not limited to, patrol/inspection, road repairs, potholes, shoulder repairs, clearing debris, illegal dumping, sidewalk maintenance, sign replacements and new installs, traffic control preparation/set-up/work zone management, roadside vegetation/minor tree trimming as well as responding to emergency situations such as road accidents/clean-up;
- Reports, monitors, and repairs all transportation infrastructure related deficiencies;
- Performs minor maintenance on all Public Works trucks and equipment as well as other maintenance and repairs as assigned.
- Performs general maintenance work including carpentry, masonry, and general labour;
- Is involved in heavy manual labour;
- Maintains accurate, detailed records of work performed and materials used through the use of technology (tablets, phones, computers);
- Adheres to all applicable safety procedures and regulations at all times to ensure a safe working environment;
