Reporting directly to the Director, Public Works, this role is responsible for the overall leadership, management, and delivery of maintenance activities, contracts, and services to the community for the Roads and Stormwater Operations/Maintenance section within Public Works. You will oversee year-round road maintenance, roadside safety device maintenance, and stormwater management programs. You will be responsible for divisional staff planning and performance management, as well as the preparation and monitoring of operating and capital budgets.

As the Manager, Roads and Stormwater Operations/Maintenance, you will perform the following duties, including but not limited to:

- Assess, develop, and monitor road, roadside, and drainage maintenance programs to ensure compliance with Federal and Provincial legislation.
- Develop stormwater management maintenance and inspection plans in compliance with provincial CLI -ECA requirements.
- Review, amend, and enforce operating policies and procedures for safe and efficient service delivery.
- Prepare, estimate, and monitor operating and capital budgets of approximately \$17 million, including procurement oversight.
- Lead, mentor, and supervise staff and contractors while ensuring compliance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act.
- Develop and execute implementation plans that support the Town's Council Work Plan and Strategic Plan.
- Participate in the development of greenhouse gas reduction and climate change adaptation plans.
