- Assist in the installation, repair, and maintenance of road surfaces.
- Operating equipment including but not limited to backhoes, loaders, graders, and tandem or single-axle trucks with snowplow equipment.
- Operate a variety of hand and power tools safely and effectively.
- Direct traffic and ensure the safety of crewmembers and the public in work zones.
- Follow established safety protocols and procedures at all times.
- Communicate effectively with team members and supervisors to coordinate tasks and workflow.
- Maintain a clean and organized work environment.

- Prior experience in road construction, maintenance, or related field preferred.

- Ability to perform physically demanding tasks in various weather conditions.
- Strong attention to detail and commitment to quality workmanship.
