Director - Transportation and Field Services

The Director of Transportation and Field Services reports to the Commissioner, Works. The Director is responsible for providing leadership for all aspects of service delivery (technical and administrative) for the transportation functions delivered by the Branch. Leadership responsibilities will include but not limited to transportation infrastructure planning, planning and design for rapid transit, active transportation and roadway structures, traffic engineering and operations, maintenance operations, and fleet services management. As a member of the Region's Senior Leadership Team, the Director will collaborate with other Works Branches and Regional departments, contributing to projects and initiatives in cross-functional areas.

The incumbent will:

- Lead capital planning, budgeting, and asset management for transportation infrastructure
- Oversee corridor control, including permitting and utilities management on Regional rights-of-way
- Coordinate utility relocations for capital projects and transportation impacts from new developments
- Guide planning, design, and pre-construction activities for projects related to structures, rapid transit deployments, and active transportation
- Manage engineering, design, construction, and operation of traffic management assets
- Administer the Region's Vision Zero program and maintain road infrastructure, traffic assets, and fleet
- Lead special transportation projects and climate change mitigation/adaptation strategies
- Develop and monitor planning initiatives and collaborate with colleagues across the Region on projects such as the Transportation Master Plan and Rapid Transit Strategy
- Coordinate with external agencies on projects and plans
- Maintain the water and sanitary sewer distribution network as co-lead for the Region's Drinking Water Quality Management System
- Collaborate on inter-Branch and inter-departmental projects and initiatives

- Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering
- Minimum 15 years of experience in planning, design, operations, and/or maintenance of transportation infrastructure
- Registration as a Professional Engineer (P.Eng.) in Ontario
- Strong leadership and managerial skills, with experience in public administration and management of human and financial resources demonstrated by several years of experience leading teams
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills, strategic planning, and conceptual thinking abilities
