Nomination Follow Up

- b. How the practice/innovation was implemented within your municipality.
- c. The timelines over which you have sustained improved efficiency, effectiveness or quality of service using the practice/innovation.
- d. What improvements have been discovered by implementing the practice (reduced cost, reduced time frames to complete work, improved quality etc.,)
- e. The measurement/metric used to determine success of the practice, and
- f. The practice/innovation must be easily transferable and non-proprietary.

Judging

- All entries will be considered open to public knowledge.
- Judging will be done by members of the Research and Product Development Committee.

Winners will be announced at the 2023 Good Roads Conference.
